Theatre Group Dzieci, founded in 1997 by Matt Mitler, is an international experimental ensemble dedicated to a search for the "sacred" through the medium of theatre. Utilizing techniques garnered from such theatre masters as Jerzy Grotowski, Eugenio Barba, and Peter Brook, ritual forms derived from Native American and Eastern spiritual disciplines, and an ethic based securely in Humanistic Psychology, Dzieci aims to create a theatre that is as equally engaged with personal transformation as it is with public presentation. The company carries their practice into hospitals and institutions that serve marginalized and disadvantaged communities, and also work with professionals and students in the fields of religion, psychology, health care, and theatre.

Matt Mitler initially trained in Humanistic and Existential Psychology before discovering the healing potential of theatre. He has had the good fortune to study with such masters as Jerzy Grotowski and Eugenio Barba in theatre; Carl Rogers and R. D. Laing in psychotherapy; and Jean Huston and Michel de Salzmann in more esoteric disciplines. Integrating these pursuits has been a lifelong process.
